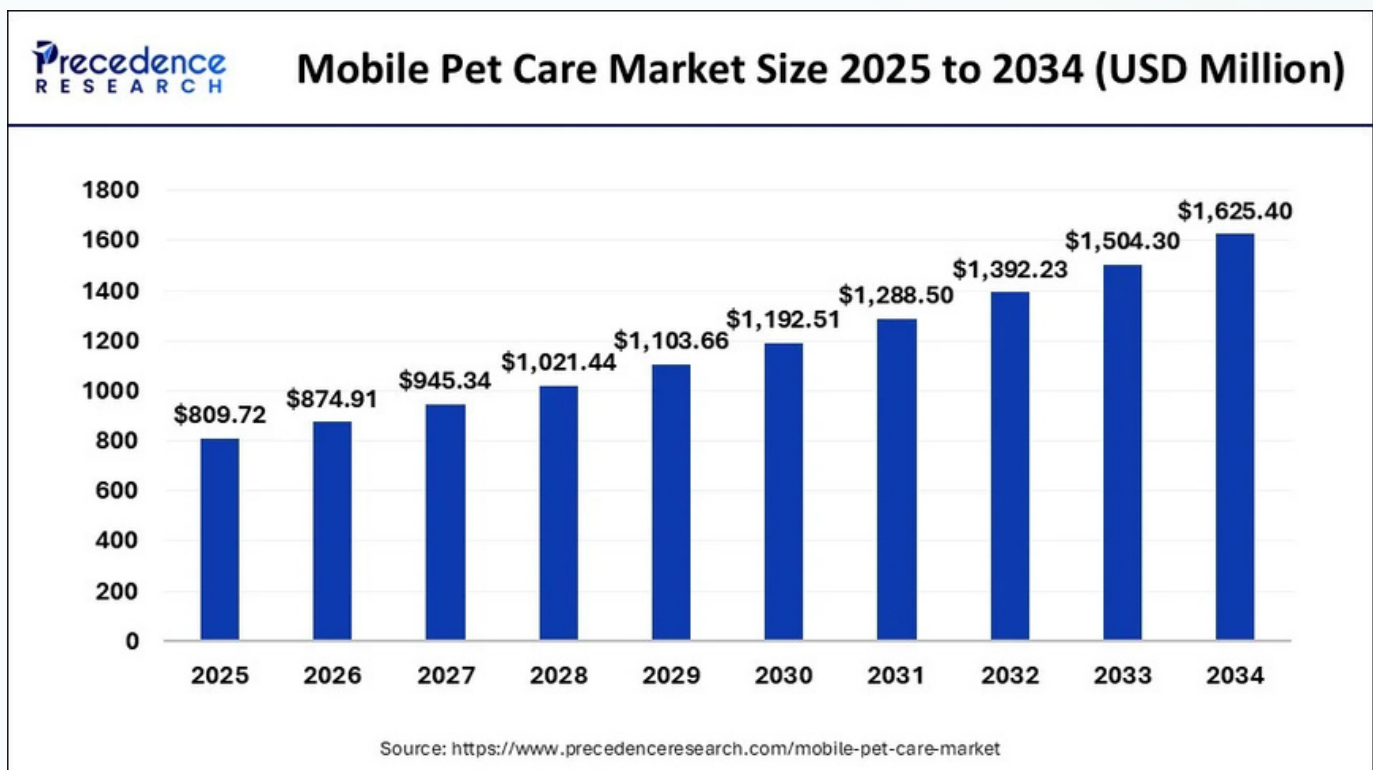

- Rushing through client appointments

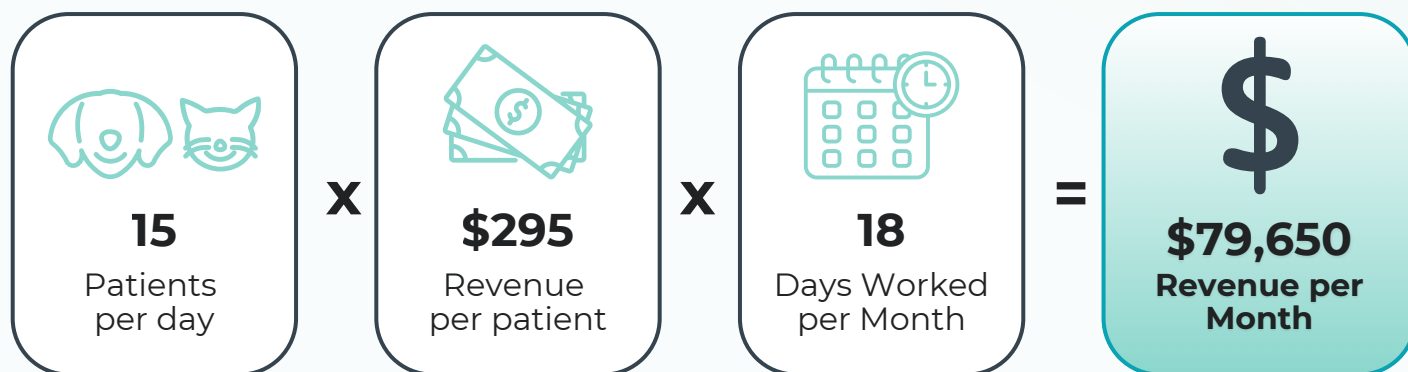
By removing these stressors, mobile veterinarians are able to have more time back for themselves, regain a passion for their work, and deliver even better care to their clients.
